

## Institute Access

The CHUV Institute for Radiation Physics is located at Grand-Pré No 1 in Lausanne, near the Malley-Lumière traffic circle and above the Fiat garage. To reach the institute :

### By train

- CFF train station : Prilly-Malley. Then walk up the Avenue du Chablais for 50 m. [Online time schedule](#)

### By Lausanne's public transportation service (TL)

- from the Lausanne CFF train station : take the m2 metro toward Croisettes, change at Flon (1st stop) then take the m1 metro toward Renens, get off at Malley (4th stop) then walk up the Avenue du Chablais for 350 m.
- from Flon Square : bus 18 toward Timonet, get off at Galicien then walk down the Avenue du Chablais for 50 m.
- from St François, Bel-Air or Chauderon Squares : bus 17 toward Renens-14 Avril or Croix-Péage, get off at Galicien and then walk down the Avenue du Chablais for 50 m.
- from the Renens CFF train station, take the north exit and then the bus 17 toward Georgette, get off at Galicien and then walk down the Avenue du Chablais for 50 m.

### By car

- Lausanne-Sud highway -> Lausanne-Malley exit -> go to Prilly/Malley
- go up the Avenue du Chablais until the Malley-Lumière Centre traffic circle. [Google Maps](#)

### Parking

- there are three «Visitor» parking spaces located just in front of the building entrance. These are reserved for short stay visitors only (participants in radiation protection courses are not allowed to use these parking spaces)
- Bourdonnette Park & Ride station : take m1 metro toward Flon, get off at Malley (1st stop) then walk up the Avenue du Chablais for 350 m. P+R Bourdonnette [P+R Bourdonnette](#)
- Underground parking lots: Malley-Lumières and Balance (facing the institute)
- Parking lot at the Malley icerink.
